special amount column

Journal amount column that is not headed with an account title

general amount column

Information for each transaction recorded in a journal

entry

Recording of debit and credit parts of a transaction

double-entry accounting

A business paper from which information is obtained for a journal entry

source document

Business form ordering a bank to pay cash from a bank account

check

Form describing the goods or services sold, the quantity and the price

invoice

Invoice used as a source document for recording a sale on account

sales invoice

Business form giving written acknowledgement for cash received

receipt

Form on which a brief message is written describing a transaction

memorandum

Determining that the amount of cash agrees with the accounting records

proving cash

Concept applied when a source document is prepared for each transaction
