accounting

A planned process for providing financial information that will be useful to management

accounting system

Organized summaries of a business's financial activities

accounting records

A business that performs an activity for a fee

service business

A business owned by one person

proprietorship

Anything of value that is owned by one person

asset

Financial rights to the assets of a business

equities

An amount owed by a business

liability

The amount remaining after the value of all liabilities is subtracted from the value of all assets

owner's equity

An equation showing the relationship among assets, liabilities & owner's equity

accounting equation

A business activity that changes assets, liabilities or owner's equity

transaction

A record summarizing all the information pertaining to a single item in the accounting equation

account

The name given to an account

account title

The amount in an account

account balance

The account used to summarize the owner's equity in a business

capital

A financial statement that reports assets, liabilities & owner's equity on a specific date

balance sheet
